

**BEGINNING MONDAY, JAN. 20,
THE NORTHBOUND I-275 RAMP
TO WESTBOUND SR 32
WILL BE PERMANENTLY CLOSED**

ADDITIONAL WORK AND LANE CLOSURES WILL ALSO BE IN PLACE

Beginning Monday, Jan. 20, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will permanently close the ramp from northbound Interstate 275 to westbound State Route 32, with motorists directed to a new ramp configuration from northbound I-275 to either east or westbound SR 32. With this new traffic pattern, a traffic signal at this intersection will go live Tuesday, Jan. 21. To accommodate work to put traffic on this new ramp, lane closures will be in place on northbound I-275, beginning at 7 p.m. Monday, Jan. 20, and reopening by 6 a.m. Tuesday, Jan. 21.

SOUTHBOUND I-275 TRAFFIC WILL BE DIRECTED TO A NEW RAMP TO EAST OR WESTBOUND SR 32

Also, ODOT will implement a new traffic pattern that will direct southbound I-275 traffic to a new ramp to east or westbound SR 32. A traffic signal at the ramp exit will go live Monday, Jan. 20.

EASTGATE BOULEVARD TRAFFIC SWITCH SCHEDULED

In addition, work to implement a traffic switch on Eastgate Boulevard is scheduled to take place on Monday, Jan. 20. Lane closures will be in place on north and southbound Eastgate Boulevard over SR 32 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Traffic will be switched from the existing bridge to the new bridge and new pavement. Traffic flow will be maintained during the switch, but delays could be possible.

Once work is complete, one lane of traffic in each direction will be in place along with a left turn lane to the ramp to eastbound SR 32. Southbound traffic will have access to one right turn lane into Best Buy, one thru lane and one left turn lane to southbound Eastgate South. Northbound traffic will have dual left access into the mall, one thru lane and one right lane to Eastgate North (Frontage Road).

With traffic placed on the new bridge, demolition of the existing Eastgate Boulevard Bridge will take place the week of Jan. 20, as well.

To accommodate that demolition, nightly lane closures will be in place on east and westbound SR 32 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., beginning Monday, Jan. 20. Work is expected to take approximately two weeks.

Arrow boards and/or signs will be in place prior to the work zone to alert motorists of the upcoming lane closures.

A PHASED PROGRAM OF IMPROVEMENTS

While we recognize that construction and the related new traffic patterns may take some time for drivers to adjust to, this work is part of an intentional, phased program of improvements that will improve safety, ease congestion and expand access to business and shopping throughout the area.
