

I-275/SR 32 Safety Improvement Work: Construction Update

As construction at the I-275/SR 32 interchange moves forward, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) continues to monitor traffic movements and the occasional delays that have resulted from the new pattern of traffic, particularly at the southbound off ramp.

ODOT is working closely with local officials, including the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District, who is responsible for several local improvements taking place around the Eastgate area, to address issues that have caused recent delays.

"Our number one priority is now, and always will be, the safety of the traveling public," said District 8 Deputy Director Steve Mary. "Our engineers are regularly monitoring and reviewing traffic at and around the interchange. We are making changes to the timing of the traffic signals to allow more 'through time' for the traffic exiting I-275 at the southbound ramp in order to alleviate back-ups on 275."

"We're on top of it," Mary continued. "We hope that drivers will keep in mind we are making transportation improvements in this area as a result of the increasing volume of traffic over many years. We have made well-considered and studied recommendations, and we are implementing a plan that will improve safety, ease congestion and expand access to business and shopping throughout the area. These improvements will not happen overnight, and until construction is complete - in 2015 - we ask that drivers remain alert through work zones, reduce speed and watch for stopped traffic."
