

I-275/SR32 Improvement Work Continues With Brief Weekend Respite

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) continues to make significant progress to improve safety in the Eastgate area by upgrading many components of the interchange network. However, drivers will notice a brief pause in construction activity over the holiday weekend. Only minor work will be completed outside the main lanes of travel on Friday, and no work will take place on Saturday, Sunday or the Memorial Day holiday on Monday. Work will resume on Tuesday.

Clough Pike Improvement Work Continues With Temporary Closure on Cider Mill Drive

The Clermont County Engineer's Office began a temporary closure on Cider Mill Drive this week to continue work on the Clough Pike Widening Project. Traffic will be detoured onto Terrace Drive for approximately three weeks while work to reconstruct Clough Pike continues. Weather permitting, the work on Cider Mill Drive will be completed by Friday, June 6, 2014, and both lanes of traffic on Cider Mill Drive will reopen at that time.

The work on Cider Mill Drive is part of 1.3 mile widening and improvement project on Clough Pike between Mt. Carmel Tobasco Road and Gleneste-Withamsville Road. The project will add a third travel lane along Clough Pike, a new center turn lane, as well as a sidewalk along the north side of the road. Upgrades will be made to nearby traffic signals, and drainage improvements will also be completed along the project corridor.
