

### Upcoming SR 32 Closures Scheduled For This Week - Weather Permitting

In order to complete bridge work for the improvements taking place at SR 32 and Eastgate Boulevard, ODOT has scheduled the following lane closures on SR 32 at Eastgate Boulevard this week. All work is weather permitting:

- **Wednesday - Thursday, October 15 - 16:**
  - 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. single lane closures - SR 32 westbound only

### Reconstruction of Eastgate Boulevard Over SR 32 Nears Completion

Major improvements to the I-275/SR 32 Interchange are taking shape, and so too are a number of supporting pieces to that work. The reconstruction of Eastgate Boulevard over SR 32 is a critical component of the work to reshape the traffic pattern in the Eastgate area in order to improve safety, ease congestion and provide the connectivity for continued economic development in the area.

Pavement work on Eastgate Boulevard was completed this past weekend and all lanes of Eastgate Boulevard are now open. (Happy driving on those newly-paved surfaces - but watch your speed!)

There is still some work to be done on the ramps that provide access to and from Eastgate Boulevard but the project team expects the major work in this area will be complete by Thanksgiving.

## ITS - This is an acronym worth knowing

We know we tend to use a good number of acronyms in the transportation industry - but here's one worth remembering: ITS - which stands for Intelligent Transportation System.

The CCTID has almost completed Phase II of its ITS work. This project involves the installation of new technology in more than 50 local traffic signals across the County. (Phase I which focused on connecting traffic signal systems in the Eastgate area has already been completed. The Phase II work makes further improvements to the Eastgate-area systems, and involves upgrades to additional systems throughout the County.)

Why do Intelligent Transportation Systems help you?

In addition to upgrading to energy-efficient LED displays and providing battery backup to the new signals, new software connects and synchronizes the signals to better monitor and control the flow of traffic through a given intersection. So rather than sitting at a light for two minutes when no traffic is coming the other way, just because that's how the signal has been timed, the new signals can more accurately monitor traffic in a given direction, and adjust signal timing accordingly.

This is smart technology that an increasing number of communities in Ohio are implementing in order to better manage traffic flow in high-volume areas. Clermont County is proud to be among the first to use this technology to improve travel in our area.
