B. Approval of Minutes

Motion by Mr. Lykins, seconded by Mr. Kuchta, to approve the minutes of the November 3, 2017 Regular meeting of the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District, as submitted, and upon roll call vote, carried with members present voting aye.

C. Transportation Improvement Projects Progress Updates

- 1. OKI/ICC Update Jeff Wright advised that the December OKI/ICC meeting was cancelled.
- 2. Eastern Corridor Segments I, II-III, IVa, Charles Rowe, ODOT, advised that the Duck Creek Connector project is complete. On Segment II-III, they are working with Stantec on getting schedules for the community meetings. On Segment IVa, the final tracings have been submitted for the eastbound 3rd lane (Glen Este Withamsville to Amelia Olive Branch) and will be submitted to Columbus before Christmas. Phases 4, 5 and 6 are going through design. Phases 7 and 8 have been authorized and Phase 9 has been set up as an authorized task. Work will continue this spring on the ramp clear project on SB 275 and SR 32 dual exit lanes.
- 3. Old SR 74 Widening Phase I Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that items 3 and 4 are part of Segment IVa. Mr. Stephenson advised that they are working with ODOT and their consultant to finalize storm water detention issues. They will then proceed into the ROW acquisition phase.
- **4.** Clepper Lane Extension Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that they recently had a productive meeting with the acquisition team and appraisal reviewer and have finalized the scope. There is a new business item on the agenda relative to the project.
- **5. Aicholtz Connector** Doug Royer, CCEO, advised that the project is complete. There is a new business item on the agenda relative to the project.
- 6. Eastgate Area Community Outreach Betty Hull, Rasor Marketing, advised that they are working with Pat Manger and Craig Stephenson on 2018 project work and on updating the newsletter. Rasor continues website monitoring and updates, community outreach, public feedback and media relations work.
- 7. Old SR 74 Widening Olive Branch-Stonelick to Armstrong Blvd. Doug Royer, CCEO, advised that the project is complete.
- **8.** Wolfpen/Pleasant Hill Road Safety Improvements Doug Royer, CCEO, advised that the project is complete. There is a new business item on the agenda relative to the project.
- 9. Branch Hill Guinea Pike at Jer-Les Drive Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that they have 3 parcels left to acquire. The utility relocation work is complete. Mr. Stephenson anticipates the start of construction in the spring of 2018.
- 10. Wards Corner Road Corridor Improvements Jeff Koehn, IBI, advised that they have the existing survey completed. They had a meeting this past Monday with Pat Manger and Craig Stephenson to discuss alignment options and to possibly get traffic count data to see if turn lanes at the intersection would be an option.
- **11. Loveland-Miamiville Road Corridor** Chad Rundle. DLZ, advised that they are looking into a few extra alternatives to zero in on a final estimate and complete the study.

- **12. Buckwheat Road Improvement Project** Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that the project is on schedule for 2018 summer construction.
- **13. Aicholtz Road Roundabouts** Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that they are waiting to hear from OKI on funding for the project.
- **14. South Afton Commerce Park** Jeremy Evans, CCEO, advised that they are waiting on Duke to provide power so that they can conduct testing of the lift station.
- **15. Half Acre/SR 276 Improvements** Jeremy Evans, CCEO, advised that the project is complete and we are working on the close-out.
- **16. SR 32 Improvements at Bell's Lane** Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that the plans will be in later today. They had a meeting with the acquisition team regarding a few ROW issues.
- 17. West Clermont Area Improvements Jeremy Evans, CCEO, advised that permanent signal installation was completed yesterday. They need to do a final inspection and complete any punch list items.
- 18. Shayler at Bach-Buxton Intersection Improvements Jeremy Evans, CCEO, advised that poles for the project are scheduled to arrive today. Signal work should move quickly once the poles arrive.
- 19. ITS Phase 3 Jeremy Evans, CCEO, advised that Stage 1 plans have been submitted to ODOT
- **20.** Chapel Woods Drive Bridge Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that the project is under construction and is 99 percent complete.
- **21. Roundbottom Road Bridge Replacement** Jon Brunot, Burgess & Niple, advised that all the preliminary work is complete. They have submitted a proposal to the County for review.
- **22. Bristol Road Bridge Replacement** Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that they are in the process of getting the boring scheduled. Stage 1 plans are 90 percent complete. They anticipate being under construction in July of 2018.
- **23.** Ninemile Road Bridge Replacement Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that Stage 1 plans were submitted for review. This project is also anticipated to begin in July of 2018. The project will require a road closure.
- **24.** Clermontville-Laurel Road Bridge Replacement Craig Stephenson, CCEO, advised that the project is on hold until next year. They will apply for OPWC funding at that time.
- **25. 2016 Landslide Repair Project** Doug Royer, CCEO, advised that 2 landslides are under contract. The Dry Run Road landslide project has a few ROW issues to resolve.
- **26. 2017 Landslide Program** Doug Royer, CCEO, advised that this will be a summer 2018 project.
