A COORDINATED APPROACH TO CONSTRUCTION

The Clermont County Transportation Improvement District (CCTID) is currently working on more than a dozen phased, integrated roadway improvements that will increase safety, support better traffic flow through the area, and provide the infrastructure for continued economic development and investment throughout the county.

These transportation improvements are not "random acts of construction," but are planned, phased, integrated projects that build upon one another (no pun intended). It may look like there's a lot going on - and there is - but it's all happening in a coordinated sequence where the construction of one project lays the foundation for the next.

What is the CCTID?

The Clermont County Transportation Improvement District (CCTID) works across geographic and political lines to improve the quality of life for Clermont County residents by stimulating economic development through regional transportation improvements. The five-member board is made up of representatives from the Clermont County Engineer's Office, the Clermont County Chamber of Commerce, the City of Milford, and Miami and Union Townships.
