### I-275/SR 32 Interchange Work Continues With New Traffic Pattern Beginning Tuesday, June 17

The Clermont County Transportation Improvement District (CCTID) works closely with the [Ohio Department of Transportation \(ODOT\)](#) to improve travel throughout Clermont County. ODOT is currently working on several major roadway improvements throughout the County, including the work at the I-275/SR 32 interchange.

ODOT has announced the following changes will take place in the I-275/SR 32 area:

- Monday, June 16 - nighttime work require lane closures from 9 PM (Monday) - 6 AM (Tuesday) on I-275 southbound and SR 32 westbound.
- Beginning at 6 AM, Tuesday, June 17, there will be a significant change in traffic pattern on I-275 and SR 32. Considerable work on southbound I-275 will require traffic to be shifted to the west in preparation for what is called a "contraflow" configuration - where both north and southbound traffic will travel on what is currently the southbound lanes of traffic. Four lanes of traffic will continue - two lanes in each direction - and additional signage will be placed throughout the area to alert motorists to the changes.
- In addition to the changes to southbound I-275, the ramp from westbound SR 32 to southbound I-275 will also be reconfigured. Beginning Tuesday, June 17, SR 32 westbound



may frustrate drivers," Manger continued. "We ask for your patience, and ask you to be mindful of the changes, plan ahead, and leave a few minutes early to allow for extra time as you drive through work areas."

Manger also reiterated that each project is happening in an integrated sequence where the construction of one project lays the foundation for the next. He added that while the priority for transportation planners is to improve safety for all who travel through the area, transportation improvements will also provide the infrastructure for continued economic development and investment throughout the county.
